The Hempfield Soccer Club and Penn Legacy desire to recognize and honor selected Hempfield Soccer Club/Penn Legacy players who, through their efforts, have promoted and exemplified the spirit of soccer in the community. The Club will award up to four \$500 scholarships to Travel players, two to boys and two to girls, graduating from high school in 2010, who plan to continue their education in an accredited post-secondary college, university, or vocational school. Scholarships will be awarded to individuals who have participated in the Hempfield Soccer Club/Penn Legacy Programs for a minimum of four years, two of which must be during the applicant's high school years.

(If you have played on both Travel and Recreation teams for the Hempfield Soccer Club/Penn Legacy, you should first determine whether you played more seasons on Recreation teams or on Travel teams and apply for the scholarship related to where you played the most seasons.)

In addition to playing on a team, the applicant must have also participated in other Hempfield Soccer Club/Penn Legacy programs by refereeing, volunteering, coaching, assistant coaching, training, lining fields, assisting with the Fall Classic or Recreational program tournaments, etc. All applications will be evaluated, using a pre-established scoring system, by a team of judges who will assign points to the applicant's answers to each of the six questions. The results of the scoring system and points assigned to each of the five questions are confidential. Every effort will be made to ensure that the scoring process is impartial and objective and that the selected applicant is the most deserving of the scholarship based on his or her answers to the questions on the application.

The applications that receive the most points in each category (Male and Female) will be selected for a scholarship awards. Financial need is not a criterion for selection in this scholarship program.

The scholarship monies must be used for the first year of full time study. The awards will be sent to the recipient upon completion of a Request for Certification of Enrollment. If an award recipient cannot provide certification of enrollment by September 15, 2010, the scholarship will be withdrawn and will then be awarded to the next qualified applicant based on the final scoring. If no other qualified applicants exist in a particular category, no award will be made for that category for that year.
